Perchnogaeth Gymunedol

Mae Llywodraeth Cymru wedi gosod targedi ar gyfer perchnogaeth gymunedol mewn ynni adnewyddadwy gan ddatgan y byddai'n dymuno gweld 1GW o ynni adnewyddadwy o dan berchnogaeth gymunedol erbyn 2030.

Wrth weithio mewn partneriaeth gyda chwmni cydweithredol ynni lleol Awel Aman Tawe a Gwasanaeth Ynni Llywodraeth Cymru, rydym yn chwilota'r posibilrwydd o gynnig cyfran perchnogaeth leol o hyd at 20%, fyddai ar gael ar gyfer buddsoddi gan unigolion lleol a chyfrff sector cyhoeddus.

Rydym yn eiddgar iawn i glywed eich barn ynglŷn â'r pwnc yma.

Community Benefit Fund

As with other similar such projects, there will be contributions made towards a Community Benefit Fund. Working with support from Neath Port Talbot Council for Voluntary Service (NPTCVS) and Bridgend Association of Voluntary Organisations (BAVO), we are currently exploring ways in which to ensure that this fund is appropriately set up to ensure ease of access and delivery once operational.

We have committed to contribute £8,000/MW (per Mega Watt) to a community benefit fund, which is far in excess of industry standard of £5,000/MW.

We would be pleased to hear thoughts on how this can be developed to ensure as much local benefit, for current and future generations, as possible.

Cronfa Budd Cymunedol

Yn yr un modd â chyda phrojectau tebyg, caiff cyfraniadau eu gwneud i fynd tuag at Gronfa Budd Cymunedol. Wrth weithio gyda chefnogaeth gan Gyngor Castell Nedd Pot Talbot dros Wasanaeth Gwirfoddol a Chymdeithas

Mudiadau Gwirfoddol Pen-y-Bont ar Ogwr, rydym ar hyn o bryd yn chwilota ffyrdd lle y gallwn sicrhau bod y gronfa hon yn cael ei sefydlu'n briodol er mwyn sicrhau ei bod hawdd cael mynediad ati unwaith ei bod ar waith.

Rydym wedi ymrwymo i gyfannu £8,000/MW (fesul Mega Watt) i gronfa budd cymunedol, sydd lawer yn fwy na'r £5,000/MW a gyfrannir gan y diwydiant fel arfer.

Byddem yn falch iawn o glywed eich barn ynglŷn â sut y gellir datblygu hwn er mwyn sicrhau cymaint o fudd lleol â phosib, ar gyfer cenedlaethau'r presennol a'r dyfodol. os yn bosib.

Buddion Lleol eraill

Community Ownership

Welsh Government has set targets for Community ownership in renewables stating that it would like to see 1GW of community owned renewable energy by 2030.

Working in partnership with local energy co-operative Awel Aman Tawe and the Welsh Government Energy Service, we are exploring the potential for providing an up to 20% local ownership stake, available for investment by local individuals and public sector bodies.
